Thanks to all who responded to our survey of the National Core Arts Standards. We are currently reviewing the data and comments.

Those of you who have been following the development and evaluations of the NCAS are well aware that these standards have been written for P-K through 12.

NYSMATA has typically attracted mostly high school and post secondary educators as members. To ease the 'signup' process, we have offered free membership for some time, and will continue to do so, at least through the coming year.

A few of our members come from the middle/junior high schools in NYS and we have some elementary school members.

NYSMATA hopes that will change this year and we ask the current membership to assist with expanding our 'reach'.


LOWER HUDSON region news

Under Tom's leadership, Westchester Community College hosted the Lower Hudson regional Youth Media Arts Show each spring for more than three decades! Thousands of high school media makers have attended these shows, exhibited work, attended workshops, and auditioned for New York State's prestigious Summer School of the Media Arts.

Tom worked tirelessly, with his staff, setting up the theater to project the films and videos and providing 'gallery' space to display the 2 D work at each March media show. Along with



Moderator (and co - President) Mike Witsch, he saw to it that the day ran smoothly and he never stopped; after each show Tom would begin thinking about the following year.

Q&A will follow with filmmaker/choreographer Peter Pucci, **co-director/producer Tony Ely,** and dancers.


